## SMS G.O.A.L.S

### Safety Awareness Bulletin 23-06 June 2023

SMS is a system for you, your company, Mesa Airlines, Inc. and the FAA, which integrates safety risk management and safety assurance concepts into sustainable and proactive systems.

### WHEN IS SMS COMPLIANCE REQUIRED?

SMS is regulatory (Title 14, CFR Part 5) and compliance is mandatory effective immediately and indefinitely.

### WHO DOES SMS APPLY TO?

SMS, as well as compliance with the contents of this bulletin apply to every individual who works for Mesa Airlines as well as those who provide a direct service to Mesa Airlines, Inc., including but not limited to the following:

- Third Party Vendors
- Contract Employees
- Essential Providers
- On-Call Maintenance Providers

### HOW DOES SMS APPLY TO YOU?

To understand how SMS applies to you, remember your SMS "G.O.A.L.S"

**G – Goal of SMS:** The goal of SMS is to manage risk as low as possible

**O – Ownership:** Understanding how your role contributes to Mesa's overall safety

**A – Accountable Executive:** The Accountable Executive is our Chief Executive Officer

**L – Look:** Look for hazards proactively (unsafe acts or unsafe conditions)

**S – Say Something:** Report hazards to the safety department via phone, email, or online report.

If you "See Something, Say Something" by openly communicating and reporting unsafe acts or unsafe conditions to your Safety Department. As a reminder, the options on the left side of this bulletin are available to you. **These options are also found on the back of your employee badge.**
